MAJOR RULE CHANGES AS OF JANUARY 1, 2016

1. Show Pleasure class has been moved from pleasure division to performance division.

(You can show a Show Pleasure horse in any class as long as it meets the requirements of that class and then go back in a show pleasure class)

- Ladies can show a stallion in <u>any</u> ladies class. (Not just in a specialty class)
- 3. There are no Novice <u>Horse</u> classes. There is a Novice <u>Rider</u> class that states no rider to have won a blue ribbon in the past 3 show seasons in that divisions to date.

 (Exception Novice Class or One Rider to Judge Class)
- 4. With a pleasure horse, you are allowed to lunge a horse with protective boots. (You cannot <u>ride</u> a horse with protective boots)
- Caveson's are <u>optional</u> with western attire country pleasure classes, easy gait, and local pleasure classes. All other pleasure classes stay the same.
